## Daniel W. Langley, D.O.

Certified by VISX to perform the LASIK procedure, as well as one of only a hand full of refractive surgeons in the Tulsa area certified to use the IntraLase laser, Dr. Langley is a skilled refractive and cataract surgeon. Dr. Langley also performs Oculoplastic procedures, such as brow and lid lifts, lesions removal, BOTOX, and other more complex eye surgeries, such as intraocular lens/contact lens placement ICL, corneal transplant, and Intacs corneal implants.
